Offerings

Denver Pet Partners conducts standards based training workshops and provides skills and aptitude assessments for prospective handler-animal therapy teams. These workshops and evaluations are led by licensed Instructors and Evaluators.

Denver Pet Partners provides site assessment, program implementation, coordination and ongoing support for facilities and institutions requesting animal-assisted therapy programs.

Denver Pet Partners carefully matches registered Pet Partners teams to facilities where they have implemented a program.

Denver Pet Partners also educates healthcare professionals to incorporate therapy animals into treatment programs through offering the Animal-Assisted Therapy Applications course.

Local Impact

Over 100 registered, skilled volunteer Denver Pet Partner therapy teams serve the community daily in healthcare, education and child welfare settings. We contribute approximately 10,000 volunteer hours per year and impact the lives of over 40,000 people annually through direct services, training courses, and community education.
