

How to Order Denver Pet Partners Trading Cards for Your Registered Therapy Animal

Many Denver Pet Partners (DPP) members have customized Trading Cards (sometimes called Visit Cards) for their therapy animal. People we visit with love to receive them, and some people collect them! Some handlers wait until the end of a visit to give them out, especially if they think they might have trouble ending the visit. This leaves those you have visited with something in their hands.

Laura Ackerman can design and order cards for you. DPP pays for them, and you reimburse DPP. They are shipped directly to you from our vendor, VistaPrint.

Here's the process to get them.

1. Email Laura at LAckerman@DenverPetPartners.org
2. In your email, include some info about your therapy animal. See the back of the following sample cards for the kinds of info people put on the cards. You do not have to use the same categories, but most people use similar ones. There is not a lot of room there, so the briefer the better.
3. Also include a photo of your therapy animal with no people in it. This photo will go on the front of the card. It can be a photo of the head only, the full body, or somewhere in between and can be horizontally (landscape) or vertically (portrait) oriented. Make sure it is a good quality photo (in focus, good lighting, etc.). Bright colors are great, but some people like more subdued tones. It is up to you.
4. If you have any questions or need any assistance, let Laura know.
5. Laura will create a proof of your card for you. This can take anywhere from a few days to a week. She will email you the proof along with pricing. Cards are available in quantities of 100, 250, and 500. Most people order 250. You will pay for the cards and for shipping directly to you. There is no sales tax.
6. Let Laura know if you are satisfied with the proof or want any changes. Also let her know how many cards you want. When you have approved the proof, Laura will place your order and send you payment information as well as an expected arrival date.
7. If you have any concerns about your cards after you receive them, let Laura know. If necessary, she will ask the vendor to remake them.
8. Out of cards? Let Laura you want to reorder and let her know if you to reorder identical cards and want to change something.
